## WNY UNITED LAUNCHES NEW WEBSITE FOR WNY CHEMICAL DEPENDENCY CONSORTIUM

The WNY Chemical Dependency Consortium is lead by a Board of Directors that represent Prevention, Treatment and Recovery. Last fall, WNY United Against Drug & Alcohol Abuse, Inc. received a grant through NY State OASAS to develop a region-wide coalition of community stakeholders across Erie, Niagara, Allegany, Chautauqua, and Cattaraugus counties which make up the Western Region Addiction Resource Collaborative.
